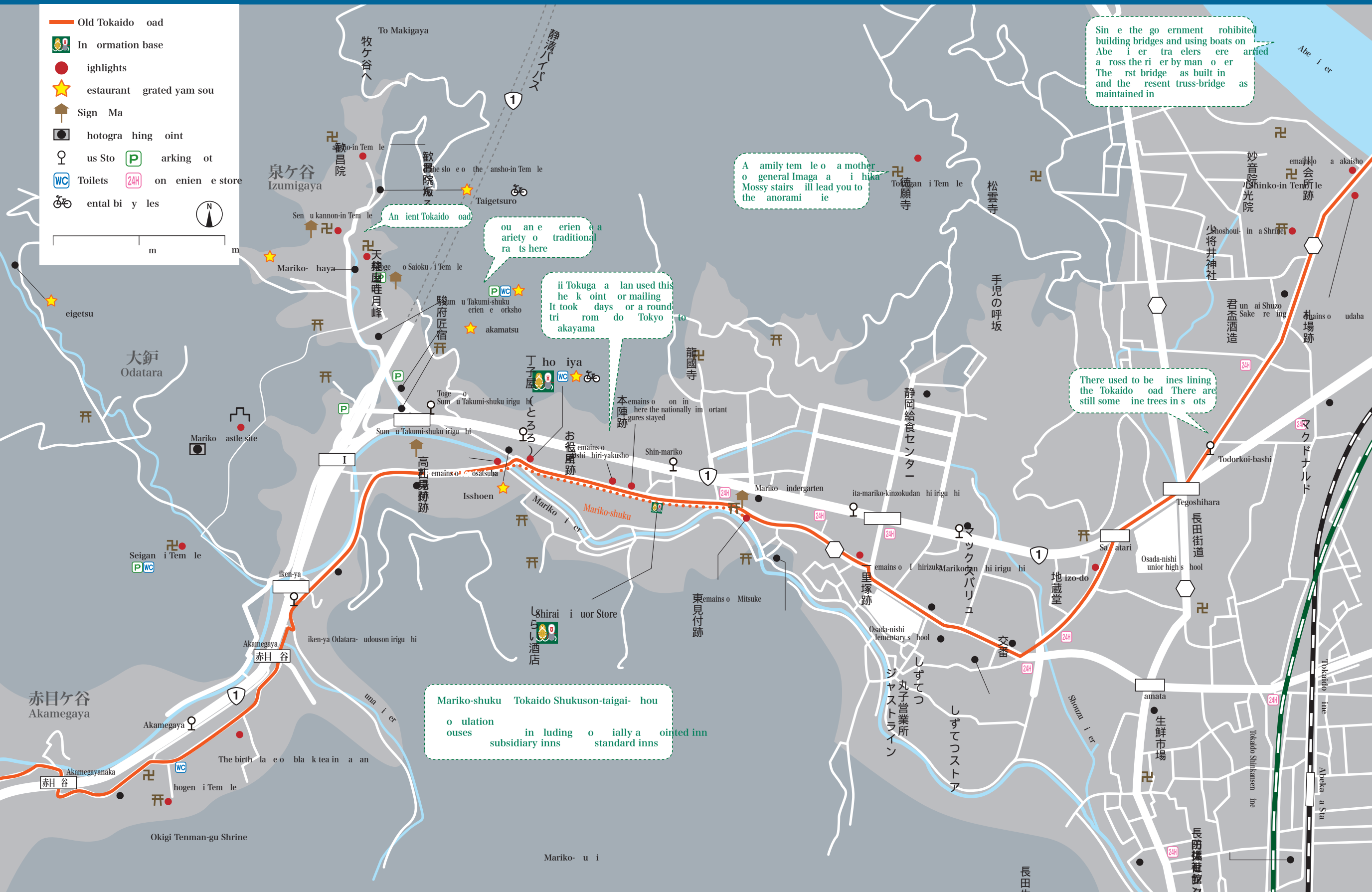

Since the government prohibited building bridges and using boats on the Abe River, travelers were forced to cross the river by means of a bridge. The first bridge was built in 1600 and the present truss-bridge was maintained in 1900.

A family temple of a mother of general Imagawa Yoshinaka. Mossy stairs will lead you to the Anoramiie.

There are a variety of traditional crafts here.

It is said that Tokugawa Iyemasa used this post station for mailing. It took 3 days for a round trip from Tokyo to Mariko-shuku.

There used to be telegraph lines lining the Tokaido road. There are still some telegraph poles in some spots.
